# Ecampus Overview

More than 900 online classes in over 90 subjects, and more continue to be added each year

2 populations: Corvallis campus and distance learners

Spring 2015 stats for distance students:  
5,584 eligible to register  
19% are DPP



***OSU Ecampus students receive the same diploma and transcripts as on-campus OSU students.***

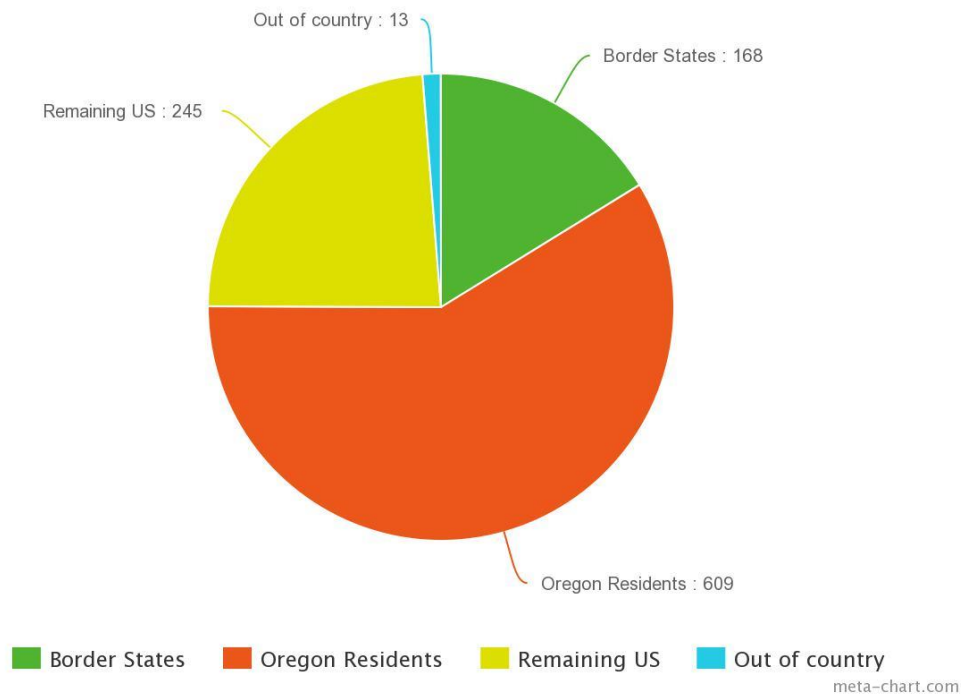
# Where are our students coming from?

# Where are our students coming from?

- 59 % in Oregon
- 41 % out of Oregon
- Residents of 4 different countries
- Military students in Europe and the South Pacific





# Why DPP for distance students?

- AAOT (90 credits) vs. lower division Baccalaureate Core (42 credits)
- Consistent academic calendar for out-of-state students
- Financial benefits
- Access to OSU advisor to maximize transfer credits
- Courses required for majors but not readily available online: Communication, Physics, etc.
- Approved articulation guides
- Expanded course access
- 10 terms available to pursue CC courses before registering at OSU
- Online format available from many DPP partners
