Do not take a course at OSU, student fees **are not** paid.

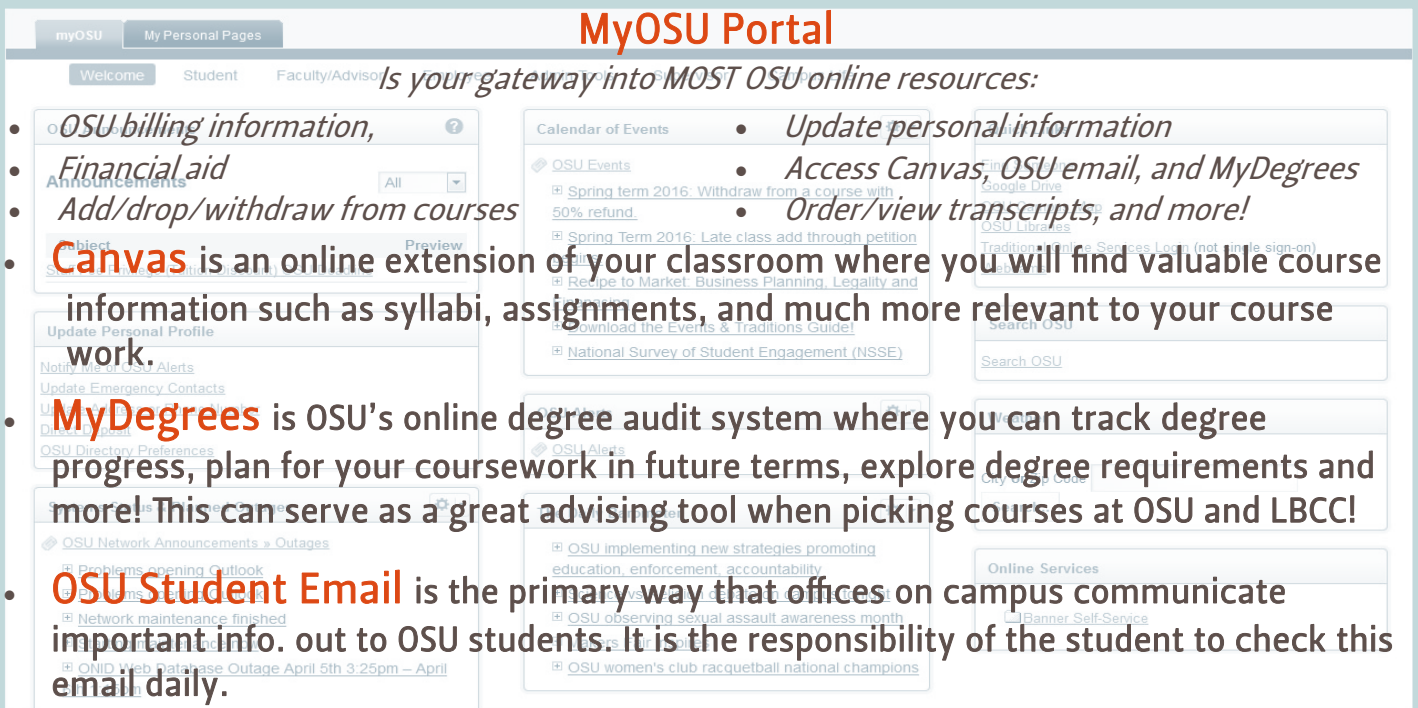
If **not** taking a course at OSU and **want to** access services paid with student fees, **visit lobby of Kerr, window 14.**

MyOSU Portal

Is your gateway into MOST OSU online resources:

- OSU billing information, Financial aid, Add/drop/withdraw from courses
- **Canvas** is an online extension of your classroom where you will find valuable course information such as syllabi, assignments, and much more relevant to your course work.
- **MyDegrees** is OSU's online degree audit system where you can track degree progress, plan for your coursework in future terms, explore degree requirements and more! This can serve as a great advising tool when picking courses at OSU and LBCC!
- **OSU Student Email** is the primary way that offices on campus communicate important info. out to OSU students. It is the responsibility of the student to check this email daily.



DPP Things to Remember

-You pay OSU for the credits you take at OSU.

-You pay your partner school for the credits you take at your Partner school.

-Your community college transcripts are sent to OSU at the end of each term.

- If there are pre-reqs for courses at your community college, request an OSU transcript be sent to the community college!

-Can take courses online or on-campus at both schools.

Funding Tips!

Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every year as soon as it is available in Oct. to be considered for the maximum amount of federal, state, and OSU loans and grants

Apply for OSU departmental scholarships every year. The applications usually are available in Nov. with a deadline in Feb. or Mar.
